

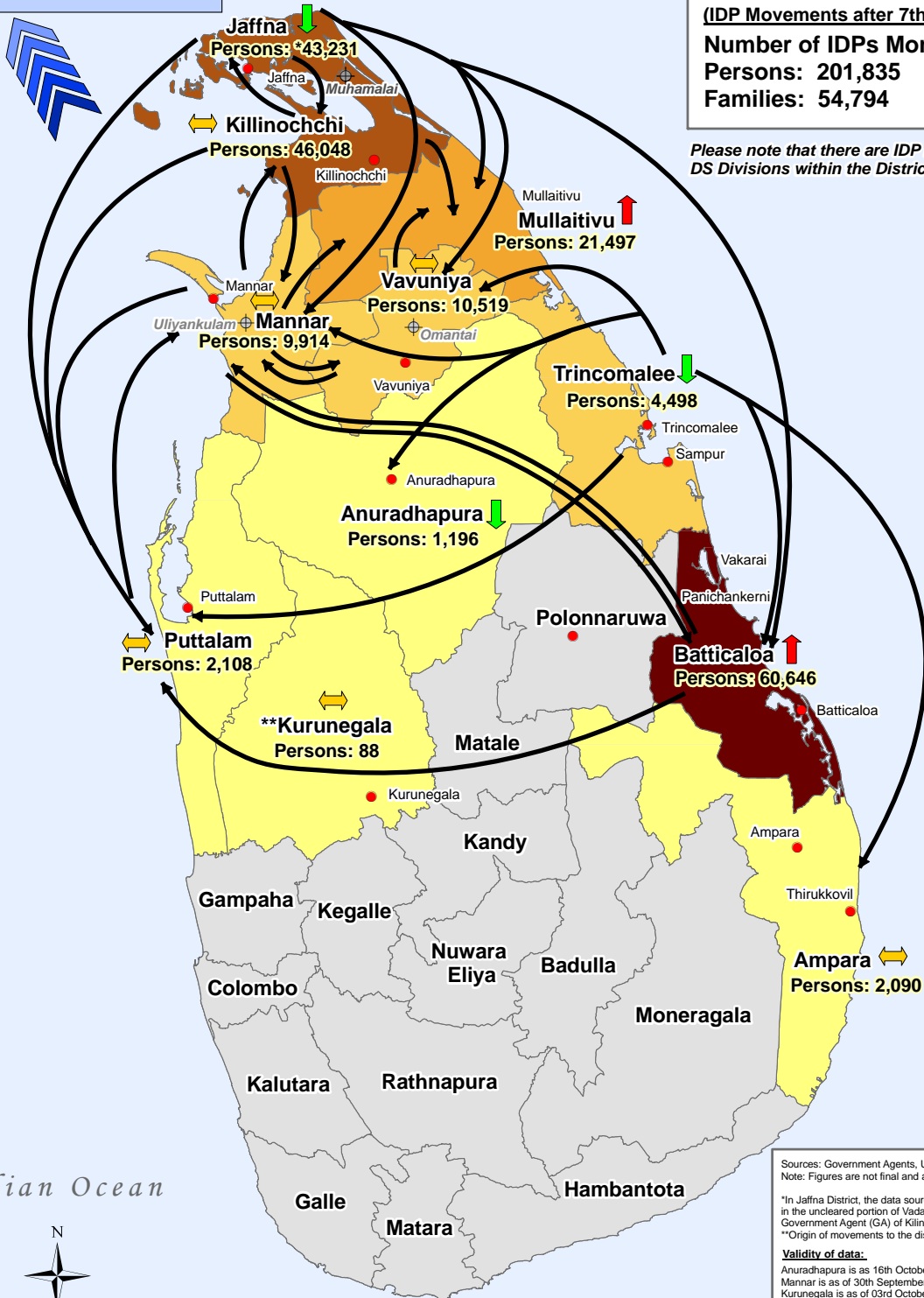
# IDP Movement Trends between Districts

Sri Lanka

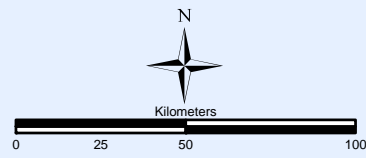
